We work with families and other service providers to provide wraparound support for the child and young person. The Senior Youth Worker will provide assistance to the Youth Services Coordinator.

Selection Criteria

- Qualifications or experience in Social Sciences or Certificate III in Community Services (or working towards)
- Ensure the provision of appropriate and effective strategies, individual and group support to young people experiencing disadvantage and adversity, while ensuring their active participation in decision-making.
- Demonstrated experience of working with at-risk youth in a case management setting, including the utilisation of effective strategies to support to young people experiencing disadvantage and adversity, while ensuring their active participation in the program.
- Have developed an awareness of the issues impacting local children and young people to ensure activities and programs are suitable, up to date and relevant to their needs eg: alcohol and drug use, sexual health, school attendance, training and employment options, health impacts and justice issues.

A current LR or HR class driver's license & a PTDA, along with a current Senior First Aid Certificate and Bronze Medallion is desirable.
